






Rromani language (i rromani čib)



- Language of the Rromani people.
- Population : 10-12 million in Europe and 3 million across the Atlantic.
- Speakers : 6-8 million.
- Indo-Aryan family.
- Mostly Indian roots, but also Greek, Persian, Georgian, Armenian roots etc.
- Inflectional language; and agglutination for postpositions.

NooJ module for the Rromani language



- Polylectal; a single and common module for the four dialects of the Rromani (O-bi, O-mu, E-bi, E-mu).
 - Mutual understanding is possible between good speakers of different dialects & various regions.
 - Diasystem; systematic correspondence of interdialectal equivalents (i.e. diasynonym).
- How to reconstruct the Rromani diasystem as module?
- Lexical resource : polylectal & multilingual dictionary *Morri angluni rromane čibăqi evroputni lavistik* (My first European dictionary of the Rromani language), Courthiade, 2009.



Region	Mutation Status	Approx. % Interdialectal Interferences
Nord-Pas-de-Calais	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Picardie	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Hauts-de-France	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Normandie	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Centre-Val de Loire	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Bourgogne-Franche-Comté	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Franche-Comté	With mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%
Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur	Without mutation / Sans mutation	~10%

Categorization of Rromani dialects for NooJ

- Dialectal properties for NooJ :
 - ✓ 2 superdialects (O, E). => rro, rre
 - ✓ 2 subgroups (without, or with mutation). => rrbi, rrmu
- Each dialect should be represented by a combination of 2 properties.

O-bi => rro+rrbi

E-bi => rre+rrbi

O-mu => rro+rrmu

E-mu => rre+rrmu



Rromani morphosyntaxe

- Rromani, a dichotomy language.
- In the case of nominal morphosyntaxe.
 - ✓ 2 numbers (singular, plural). => sg, pl
 - ✓ 2 genders (masculine, feminine). => m, f
 - ✓ 2 flectional cases (direct, oblique). => dr, ob
 - ✓ 2 functional cases (with preposition, or postposition)
=> PREP, PSTP



Postpositions

- The initial Rromani module considers the postpositions to be inflectional endings.
- 4 invariable postpositions.
 - ✓ -qe : dative =>dat *for*
 - ✓ -ça : instrumental =>ins *with*
 - ✓ -θar : ablative =>abl *from*
 - ✓ -θe : locative =>loc *at*
- 1 variable postposition.
 - ✓ -qo/-qi/-qe : possessive =>poss *of*



Uncountable nouns in Rromani

- Types of nouns based on the numbers.
- ✓ Countable (singular, plural)
ruv wolf vs **ruva** *wolfs*, **dand** *tooth* vs **danda** *teeth*
- ✓ Only plural
lima snot, pixa eye-rheum
- ✓ Uncountable
love money, pani water, mas meat



Uncountable nouns in Rromani

Okote si jekh ruv.

A wolf is there.

Okote si but ruva.

Many wolfs are there.

Si man but love.

I have a lot of money

Piav but pani.

I drink a lot of water.

Xav but mas.

I eat a lot of meat.

Akate si jekh lovorro.

One coin is here.

Xalom marikli maseça.

I ate pie with meat.

Xalom marikli masença.

I ate pie with mixed meat.


Buuuut masa si akate!

Here is a loooot of meat!

- To import the published dictionary to NooJ dictionary, we have to advance diasystem study and then to check the coherence at dialectological & technical levels.
- The grammar .nom for postpositions is a test pattern and has not been completed.
- About uncountable nouns, we could define some more types of specificities.


